**Jason Choi** has been recognised as one of the seven academics from the University of Liverpool named in a prestigious annual list of ‘highly cited’ researchers.

## Research Funding

**Hossein Sharifi** is leading a multi-partner team that has been awarded £30,000 from The Pandemic Institute.
